



The New Drone Reality


Drones are creating new threats that endanger both officers and the communities they protect.



U.S. border agents have been warned that Mexican drug cartels may use weaponized drones in escalating border violence.



A drone collided with a firefighting aircraft during LA's Palisades Fire, grounding the plane for five days and impeding fire suppression efforts.



In South Carolina, 20 people were arrested after using drones to smuggle over 100 pounds of contraband into a prison.
