


Corrections and Contraband: **Protecting Prisons from Unauthorized Drones**

Unauthorized drone use poses an **immediate** threat to correctional facilities. Criminals and syndicates are using drones to smuggle contraband into prisons, from drugs and cash to phones and weapons.
